



RING SIZING CHART

The most accurate way to find your ring size is to have it measured by a professional jeweler. They will usually do it for free.

If that's not an option, there are other ways to figure it out.

- Print out this page at 100%. Use the 3 1/2" guide at the bottom of the page to ensure that it's printed to the correct size.
- If you have a ring that's the size you want, place it on the circles to determine it's size. Make sure that the outside of the circle matches the inside of the ring.
- If you don't have a ring the right size, cut out the ring guide below. Make a slit at "A" and insert "B" through it to form a circle. Try it on and read the size to determine your ring size.
- You may also purchase a plastic ring sizer on my website. You can find it listed with the rings.
- **NOTE:** Wide band rings fit tighter than regular rings. You will need to go up 1/2 to a full size when ordering a wide band ring.
